

Harvest Trauma Recovery Center

October 2025-Present--
170 clients served clinically (HTRC and school-based clients).

Twenty-seven percent (27% or 46) of current clients are dual diagnosis- Mental health diagnosis and substance related disorder.

Sixty-three percent (63% or 5 out 8) of shooting incidents resulted in a family members death.

Twenty-two percent (22% or 22) of those being served for Violent Domestic Disputes, Partner Violence or Sexual Assault are Perpetrators.

Fifty-eight percent (58% or 58) of current clients are diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder

Three (3) clients have been hospitalized during this period for active suicidal ideation with a plan.

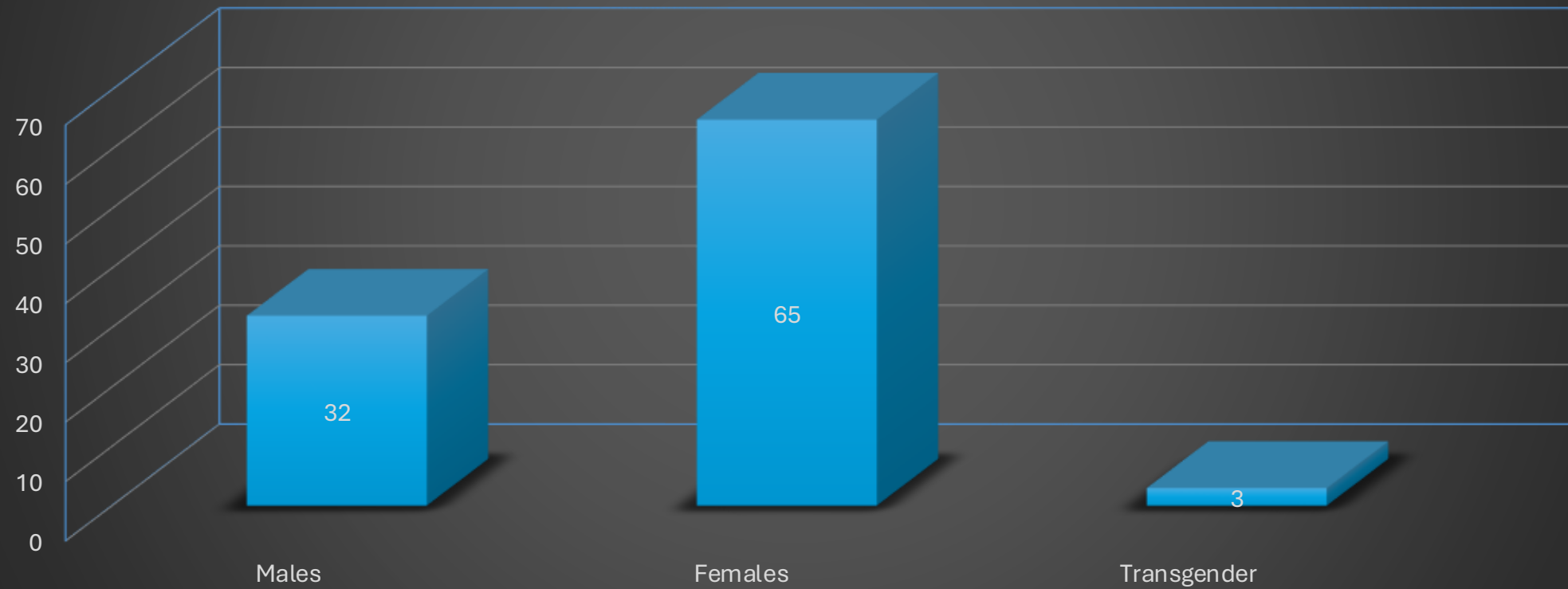
Number of survivor cases that meet the NATRC Criteria

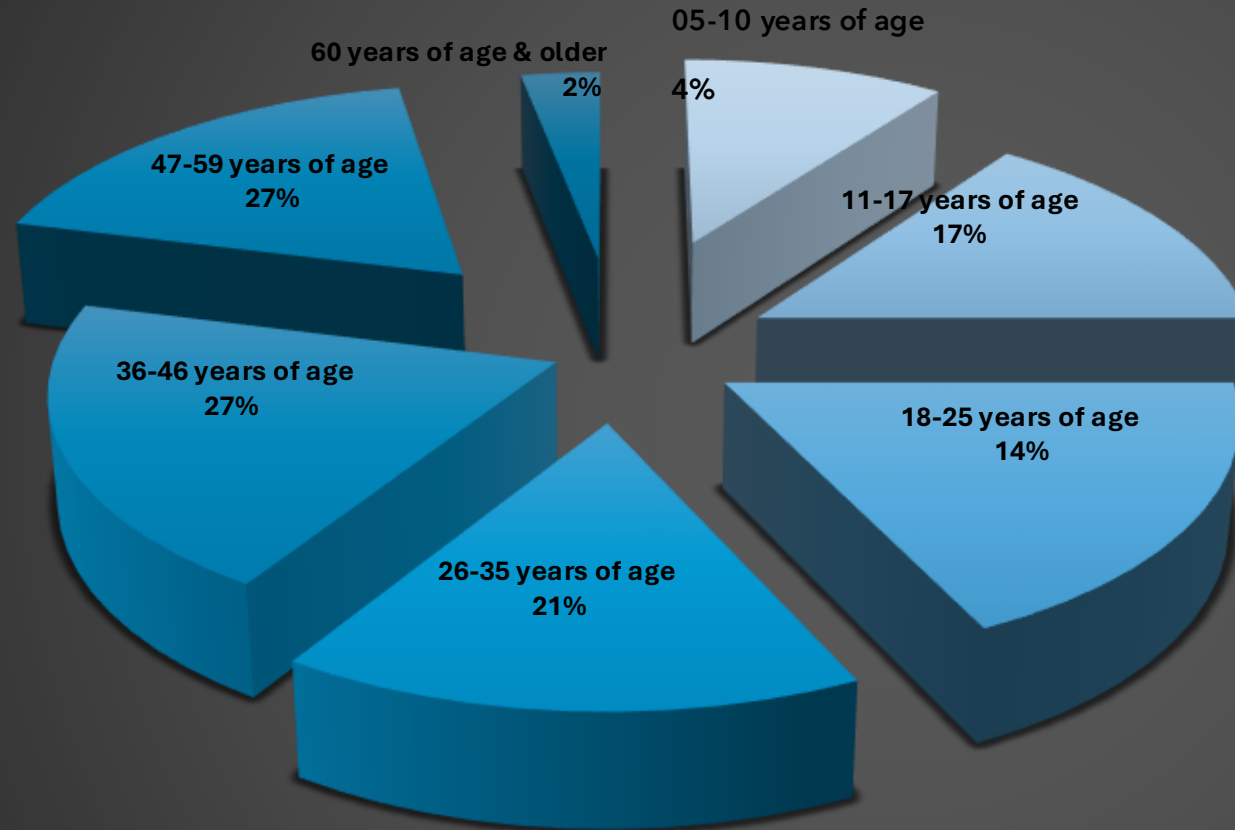

Gender



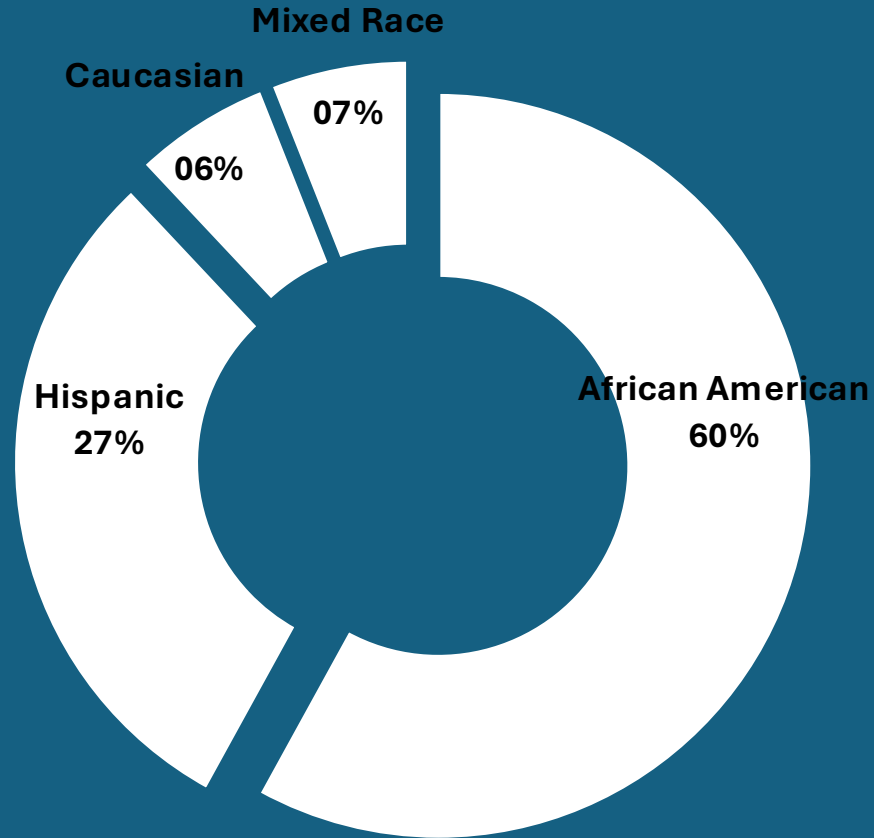
Age Dispersion

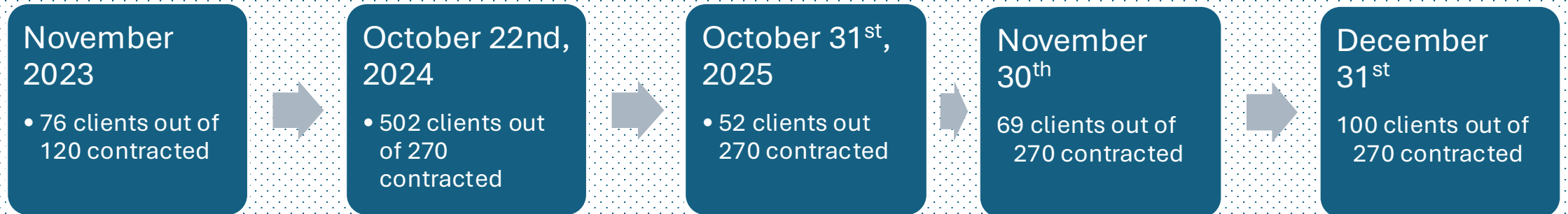

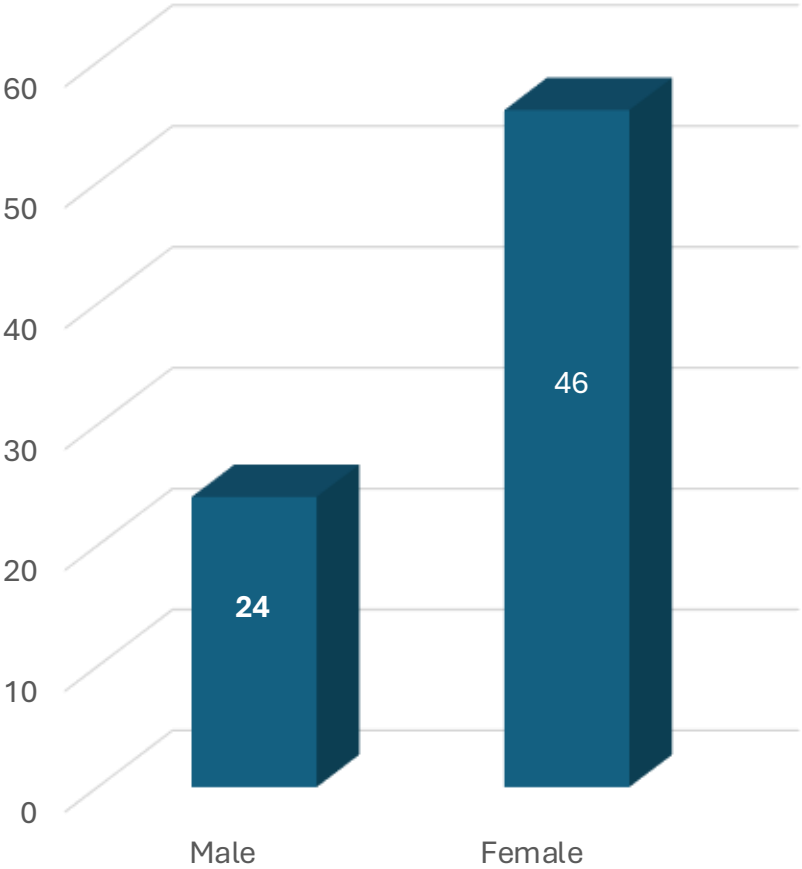
